Jeanne Murray lives by a simple motto when she describes her 57 years of community service. She says "It's what gives you a feeling inside and makes you feel good". There is a sense of conviction and honour when she speaks of serving her community where she worked bingos, ran BBQs for local team sports and took on the duties of a Girl Guide Commissioner and Leader organizing camping trips in bear country in Northern British Columbia.

Jeanne was born and raised on a farm near Fort St John, BC. Her father raised cattle and her mother was a homemaker. Jeanne along with her brother and sister grew up as she says "in a different time" when describing her childhood. She remembers fondly getting to ride her own horse to school and back for nearly 6 years. She recalls that "the only time it wasn't fun was when it was minus 30 out."

For over 40 years, Jeanne and her family have called South Clareview home. She still lives in the same home in Belmont since 1977. Her children were active in community programs and sports. Jeanne always lent a hand when the teams needed fundraising. She goes on record to saying that she worked hundreds of Bingos over the years. She currently is the longest serving member of the SCCL executive with 14 years as Treasurer and currently as its Casino and Bingo coordinator. Jeanne acknowledges that the community relies a great deal on these fundraising efforts and quickly points out "it helps keeps the lights on."

Jeanne married in 1959 and had 5 children. Her children are all grown up now and are pursuing their own careers. She has 9 grandchildren and 2 great grandchildren. "I know my kids want me to slow down but I like what I do here."
