### **Anne Fitzgerald Catholic School 100 Voices Pre-Preschool Program Northeast Edmonton**

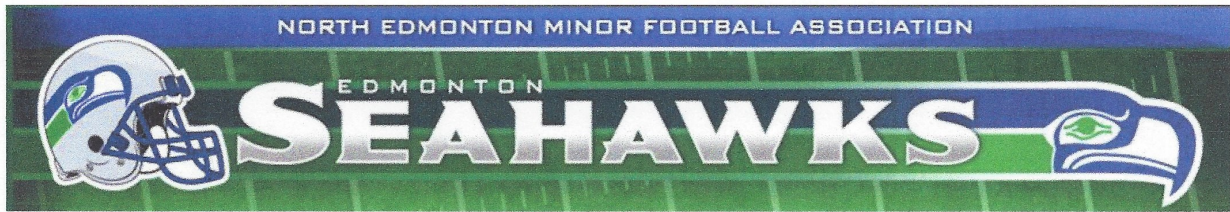
